

**Congressman Don Davis has voted 88% of the time
(15 out of 17 floor votes under a special rule)
with Republicans on border security**

January 7, 2023: Congressman Davis is sworn in to the 118th Congress.

February 9, 2023: VOTED YEA - H.J.Res.24 - Disapproving the action of the District of Columbia Council in approving the Local Resident Voting Rights Amendment Act of 2022.

May 8, 2023: CO-LED H.R. 3234, to extend Title 42 Authorities that would minimize unlawful migrant crossings and did so during the pandemic.

May 11, 2023: Congressman Davis speaks on the House Floor in opposition to the E-verify provisions in H.R. 2, and is joined by a bipartisan majority in opposing the legislation. On that same day, Rep. Newhouse spoke in opposition to the E-verify section.

May 11, 2023: VOTED NAY - H.R.2 - Secure the Border Act of 2023

May 19, 2023: Congressman Davis visits the Brownsville, TX Port of Entry to tour migrant overflow and the McAllen border patrol facilities, including part of the border wall.

May 19, 2023: Congressman Davis references a "border crisis" during an interview with local station WITN.

July 27, 2023: Congressman Davis introduces H.R. 4988, the Modern Authentication Pharmaceuticals Act, legislation to stem the flow of counterfeit pharmaceuticals, including fentanyl, by requiring on-dose identification of controlled substances.

November 11, 2023: VOTED YEA - H.R.5283 - Protecting our Communities from Failure to Secure the Border Act of 2023

January 5, 2024: Congressman Davis visits Eagle Pass, TX, with Rep. Gonzales (R-TX), to tour the site of the record-breaking migrant crisis during Christmas 2023.

January 17, 2024: VOTED YEA - H.Res.957 - Denouncing the Biden administration's open-borders policies, condemning the national security and public safety crisis along the southwest border, and urging President Biden to end his administration's open-borders policies.

January 31, 2024: VOTED YEA - H.R. 6679 - No Immigration Benefits for Hamas Terrorists Act

January 31, 2024: VOTED YEA - H.R. 6976 - H.R. 6976, the Protect Our Communities from DUIs Act

January 31, 2024: VOTED YEA- H.R. 6678, the Consequences for Social Security Fraud Act - Expands the bill to require that any alien who has been convicted of or admits to having committed a crime involving financial misconduct in regards to certain COVID-19 loans be inadmissible and deportable.

January 31, 2024: VOTED YEA - H.R.5585 - Agent Raul Gonzalez Officer Safety Act

February 13, 2024: VOTED NAY - H.Res.863 - Impeaching Alejandro Nicholas Mayorkas, Secretary of Homeland Security, for high crimes and misdemeanors.

March 7, 2024: VOTED YEA - H.R.7511 - Laken Riley Act

March 12, 2024: VOTED YEA- H.Res.1065 - Denouncing the Biden administration's immigration policies

March 13, 2024: SIGNED - H.Res. 1027 - Discharge Petition providing for consideration of H.R. 7372, the Defending Borders, Defending Democracies Act, which included the Remain in Mexico policy.

April 2, 2024: Congressman Davis visits the Mariposa Port of Entry in Nogales, AZ, to survey the Tucson Sector, which ranks highest in fentanyl seizures across all border patrol sectors.

April 20, 2024: VOTED YEA - H.R. 3602, the End the Border Catastrophe Act

May 1, 2024: VOTED YEA - H.Res.1112 —Denouncing the Biden administration's immigration policies. (sponsored by Rep. Gonzales)

May 15, 2024: VOTED YEA — H.R. 8146 – Police Our Border Act

May 15, 2024: VOTED YEA — H.R. 7343 – Detain and Deport Illegal Aliens Who Assault Cops Act

May 15, 2024: VOTED YEA — H.Res. 1210 – Condemning the Biden border crisis and the tremendous burdens law enforcement officers face as a result

June 28, 2024: VOTED YEA — H.R. 8752 – Department of Homeland Security Appropriations Act, 2025
