I am requesting funding for the Hertford County Security Program project in fiscal year 2025.

The entity to receive funding for this project is Hertford County, North Carolina, located at:

115 Justice Drive, Winton, NC 27986

The \$385,729 in funding is for in-car cameras for Hertford County, to be used by the Hertford County Sherriff's Office. The cameras will activate with the taser being turned on and the signal sidearm attached to our duty holsters. Basically, the camera activates when the duty weapon is drawn from the holster. These also have license plate readers that works in conjunction with Flock camera systems. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because this would also replace the existing mobile data terminals in patrol vehicles as well. The license plate readers will have a positive impact on active investigations providing objective data to law enforcement. The cameras, especially as they connect to the drawing of a firearm or taser, will increase the protection for the officer and accountability for the use of force by an officer. Upgrading the MDT will assist officers with communications and access to county and statewide criminal justice networks, DCI. Improving public safety is always a good use of taxpayer funds.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Section 501 of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C. § 10152)
