Dear Chairwoman Granger and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Town of Plymouth Surveillance Equipment Project in fiscal year 2024.

The entity to receive funding for this project is the Town of Plymouth, located at:

124 E. Water Street
Plymouth, North Carolina 27962

The Town of Plymouth would use \$325,000 to purchase and install surveillance equipment to reduce escalating violent crime, including assaults, as well as property crime and organized drug activity. The initiative would directly support coordinated regional crime reduction. In recent years, homicides in Plymouth and the surrounding area have increased, along with burglary and other crimes targeting law enforcement and private citizens. Federal funds could expedite investigations to ensure swift prosecution for heinous crimes.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized in section 501 of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C. § 10152).
