I am requesting funding for the Town of Grimesland Street Repaving project in fiscal year 2024.

The entity to receive funding for this project is the Town of Grimesland, located at:

The funding would be used for the street repaving of a large section of essential roads for the Town of Grimesland, North Carolina. 100% of funds will be allocated for the street repaving project. Roughly twenty-two streets (3.31 miles) of in-town streets will be repaved along with dirt and gravel roads, and alley ways. This project is a good use of taxpayer funds because this would be for the safety of the residents and the thousands of commuters who pass through our town daily, as well as further developing the economic footprint of the town by providing better roads for all drivers to travel on and encouraging commerce across the community.
